#1 AIRWAY (is person breathing?)

Head - Tilt / Chin lift
Place ear close to victim's mouth.
Look, listen & feel abdomen.
Document abnormal lung sounds.
(Some times allow patient to sit up)

- . Not breathing after 2 attempts TAG DEAD
- More than 30 breaths = TAG I Immediate
- **Below** 30 breaths = (GO to circulation)

#2 CIRCULATION (is person bleeding?)

- Immediately stop severe bleeding!
- · Press finger = Capillary refill.
 - More than 2 seconds = TAG I = Immediate (treat for shock)
 - Less than 2 seconds = (move to Mental evaluation)

BLEEDING TYPES

Arterial = spurts = direct pressure, elevate (above heart), pressure points.

Venous = flow = direct pressure, elevate (above heart).

Capillary = ooze = direct pressure, elevate (above heart).

Tourniquets (optional) = between wound and heart.

- Mark patient has tourniquet.
- Do not loosen after applied

Pressure Points

Brachial point = arm (inside and just above elbow)
Femoral point = leg (inside and upper thigh)
GET PERMISSION!!
Popliteal point = behind knee
